

**1. Vehicle Volume, London Rd
11-13 January 2017. Pen and paper glimpse.
Observed by John Fox, from 31 London Rd**

a). Wednesday 11 January 2017, 7.25-8.25, DRY

Traffic Flow: 104 LGV; 8 HGV; 13 buses; **682 vehicles in all, both ways.**

b). Thursday 12 January 2017, 7.30-8.30, DRY

Traffic Flow: 117 LGV; 7 HGV; 13 buses; **802 vehicles in all, both ways.**

c). Friday 13 January 2017, 7.30-8.30

Traffic Flow: 90 LGV; 12 HGV; 13 buses; **605 vehicles in all, both ways.**

2. SUMMARY

Vehicles using London Rd, 7.30-8.30, a.m.

Wed., 11 January, Thur., 12 January, Fri., 13 January 2017

a) 682 total both ways (incl 104 LGV, 8 HGV, 13 buses)

b) 802 total both ways (incl 117 LGV, 7 HGV, 13 buses)

c) 605 total both ways (incl 90 LGV, 12 HGV, 13 buses)

Average 696 vehicles per hour

The independent Wheatley Traffic Survey (pub. January 2014)

found an average of over 600 vehicles p.h. using London Rd, peak period, 2013.

This suggests (no more) a one-sixth increase in the average since 2013.
