WNP Interview with Wheatley Area Churches Committee

RG and JF met with the Committee 4^{th} October. Half an hour given of Committee time. Present CofE, URC and RC church including ministers from all 3.

- 1. WNP was explained to the Committee. 'Community listening'.
- 2. Absence of Youth Service in a village with full complement of schools was raised, Memorable past service by Chris Sewell (decades ago) and recently by Dan Oosterhuis with *Fusion* (two years full time grant), currently some part time work in school lunch hour.
- 3. The church cemetery almost full. Now a civil Parish responsibility. Burial still means more in a village like Wheatley (50:50 preferences) than in a town or suburb.
- 4. Asked churches to think about publicising the fact of the NP referendum sometime in 2017. CofE always requests from the pulpit that people use their vote as a duty. URC long history of community involvement and providing a roof for meetings/groups.
- 5. Implications of new housing: a) additional members of congregations b) need for community welcome (CofE planning it for the upper London Rd development of 51 houses)
- 6. Feedback from congregations to WNP on new development welcome any time.
