1. Events during the 6 week Consultation. It was agreed to have an early Presentation and a late Surgery, both with Questions and Answers. KH offered use of the Wheatley Park Academy and that was later booked for Sat 13 April, 6.30 for 7.00. The Surgery will take Place at the Merry Bells, Sat.11 May, 10.00 – 15.00.
2. RG explained that Two documents are required for Consultation: the Draft WNP and the Environmental Report required of WNP by the major Statutory Bodies. Comment will be required on the Draft WNP, (which also includes two Appendices – Character and Sites Selection) but no comment will be made on the independent Environmental Report drawn up by AECOM, still being awaited..
3. Rebecca Graham offered to edit the FLYER to be inserted in 2000 + Newsletters delivered at the end of March . Roy Gordon will have the hard copies of WNP and ER documents printed. AP will keep the website updated.
4. Other documents required of or advised to the WNP Committee will be listed. All will go to the Inspector as part of the 'package'. The Statutory Consultation Statement can only be shown as a complete document when the outcome of this pre-Submission Final Public Consultation is known and recorded. The WNP itself, (Version 34), shows no change in Policies or in what the Committee and the Community wish to propose, from the Version presented to the FIRST Public Consultation (May, June 2017)
